ICDL Start – Providing Teachers and Ministries of Education with successful ICT skills globally. The International Computer Driving Licence (ICDL) START Program is a certificate which certifies the passing of any four modules of the ICDL programme. The ICDL Start certificate will list the four modules chosen and completed by the trainee.

The ICDL START program is the completion of any four of the above seven modules. Each module is approximately 7 hours in duration inclusive of the  $\frac{3}{4}$  hour exam at the end of the training. When you complete and pass any four modules, you will receive your ICDL START certificate.

## Key Facts

Outside of Europe the qualification is known as the International Computer Driving License (ICDL) Used internationally by a number of Ministry of Education programmes including:

- Poland: 5,900 teacher training programme with 3,500 trained and certified to date
- Kosovo: 27,000 teacher training programme with 5000 teachers trained and certified during phase 1
- Vietnam: 1,500 pre-service student teachers trained annually
- Italy: 80 middle schools, 1900 high schools and 200 universities involved in certifying 900,000 candidates since 1999.
