



THE ICDL SYLLABUS VERSION 4.0 IS NOW AVAILABLE

The ICDL Syllabus Version 4.0 is now available. The official release date for syllabus version 4.0 was 1 July 2004. Syllabus version 3.0 will remain valid for testing only up to 31 December 2004.

We have taken into consideration the time it will take to implement syllabus version 4.0 by providing our Test Centres with a six month transition period. This will enable you to plan and prepare towards having syllabus version 4.0 in place for the 2005 academic year.
