In March 2002, The Knox School implemented the ICDL program for the first time targeting parents, teachers, local businesses and community members. The response was overwhelming with three full classes booked almost immediately. Participants, ranging from doctors, nurses, dentists, administrators, counsellors, mums, dads and small business owners all joined together to complete their ICDL studies at Knox.

Course coordinator, Jo Trinder, assisted participants of varying skill levels through the steps of the ICDL program assuring each individual gained a sound understanding of the topics. One participant stated, *'Great start! I now understand lots more about terminology that were just words before. The software is really user friendly and I like that you can move through it at your own pace. Teacher is great.'*

The course, aimed at furthering mature age education and IT skill development, progressed over a ten-week period with the option of Wednesday, Thursday or Saturday classes. The programme involved both practical exercises relating to the module being studied and the use of the Computer Based Training (CBT) material.

On commencing each module, tests were conducted requiring each student to demonstrate practical skills and a working vocabulary of computer terms.

The Knox School endeavors to support local businesses and individuals and, through the ICDL program, Knox has had the opportunity to successfully promote further education to the wider community.
